Application for Conversion of DSC 1 To include Trained Hunter Competence

Individuals may now undertake to upgrade their Deer Stalking Certificate 1, to include the Wild Game Meat Hygiene for trained hunter status by attending and passing a fifth assessment.

This qualification is available by attending a BDS run DSC1 assessment event and will take approximately 1 hour. No tuition will be given but the information required to pass the assessment is available by purchasing the BDS Training Manual priced at £30.00 plus postage and packing.
