



CAPTIVE AND ENCLOSED DEER SURVEY

Thank you for helping the BDS to collate and maintain records of all deer held in captivity or enclosed by deer proof boundaries within the United Kingdom. The information we collect will form a unique database of all captive deer in this country. It will have multiple applications varying from listing publicly accessible deer collections, holding data on file in the event of disease outbreaks, and informing park owners to assist the circulation of livestock or preventing in-breeding of vulnerable species.

Access to all records held will be strictly controlled. Only details of establishments normally accessible to the public will be made openly available through the BDS website. Private establishments will be recorded separately.

Notes for completion:

- Essential information needed for the Survey is **indicated in bold**. This will ensure that it can be suitably arranged and accessed. Otherwise please provide as many other details as you can.
- Only details of establishments in Great Britain and Northern Ireland are requested.
- All deer held captive, irrespective of species or wild status in the UK, should be recorded.
- Deer which are not held fully captive or enclosed should not be recorded.
- Please tell us about all parks, farms and deer collections known to you, however well known. Duplication is preferable to omission because of assumed common knowledge.
- There is no need to make direct approaches to owners or managers of establishments; if necessary the BDS will follow up with any enquiries.
