Application to attend a Deer Stalking Certificate 1 Course

DSC1 is a three-day course and comprises of a series of lectures, slide presentations, videos, and discussion. At the end of the course there are five assessments to be undertaken resulting in a DSC1 Certificate for those who achieve the pass grade.

The cost of the course is **£295.00**, which includes instruction, assessment, DMQ registration and a comprehensive BDS Training Manual. To secure a place on the course full payment in advance is required. Once the booking is made, a course manual, joining instructions and programme will be provided. **The cost does not include accommodation, meals or any ammunition used when borrowing a rifle, ammunition will be charged as per the details in the course joining instructions.** If you have any queries about accommodation or the programme, please contact the Course Manager direct whose details will be in the course joining instructions.

All candidates holding a legal deer rifle for use in the country where the course is being held will be required to bring it for the shooting assessment conducted during the course.

Those candidates who do not own a deer legal rifle may be able to borrow one and will need to become a member of the BDS to comply with Home Office regulations and BDS Gun Club rules. **Candidates should check their situation well in advance with the Course Manager.**
